# RFP 3757

In its continuing effort to further public safety interoperability the State of Mississippi Wireless Communication (WCC) is soliciting proposals for a unified P25, VoIP push to talk (PTT) solution to be added to its P25, phase 2, statewide network.

# RFP 3757

The solution will extend P25 features and functionality to public safety smartphone users anywhere in the public cellular 3G, 4G, LTE and Wi-Fi network(s). Upon its implementation the WCC will offer public safety executives and managers the ability to interoperate with the Mississippi Wireless Information Network (MSWIN) subscribers by way of voice and text messages and pass real-time location information to appropriately equipped devices.

# Project Overview

- This RFP encompasses all tasks associated with the design, development, project management, planning, prototyping, building, installation, testing and implementation of the solution.

# Project Overview (cont.)

- The solution must interface to the MSWIN CORE or to the P25 ISSI. VoIP PTT systems repeating “off air” talkgroup traffic are not permitted;

# Project Overview (cont.)

- The Vendor's proposal shall include a 'firewall' located at the network gateway server. The firewall shall protect the resources of the MSWIN private network from users from other networks. The firewall configuration shall conform to the State of Mississippi's Enterprise Security Policy. Please refer to Section IV, Item 32 for additional information regarding the policy.
