The Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services (ITS) is inviting interested parties to meet with project staff to discuss the Mississippi Vehicle Insurance Verification System (MSVIVS). MVIVS will provide the State with automated verification of a vehicle's motor vehicle insurance status. During the 2012 Regular Session, the Mississippi Legislature passed Senate Bill No. 2631 to create the Public Safety Verification and Enforcement Act. This Act requires DPS, in cooperation with DOI and DOR, to establish an accessible common carrier-based motor vehicle insurance verification system to be used by law enforcement agencies and the DOR to identify uninsured motorists.

ITS will schedule demonstrations for interested vendors from 1:00PM – 4:00PM on Thursday, January 8, 2015 or 8:00 – 4:00 on Friday, January 9, 2015. Ninety minute sessions will be scheduled on a first come – first served basis. The meetings will be held on the 1st floor of the ITS Building, 3771 Eastwood Drive, Jackson, MS 39211.
