2017 Legislative Summary

House Bill 649 (Regular Session 2017), *effective July 1, 2017*

Approved by Governor Bryant on March 10, 2017

- Creates the Mississippi Data Management Working Group to study agency data sources and develop policy in respect to managing data as a strategic asset.

House Bill 999 (Regular Session 2017), *effective July 1, 2017*

Approved by Governor Bryant on March 10, 2017

- Creates new Section 25-53-201, Mississippi Code 1972, establishing the Enterprise Security Program which shall provide for the coordinated oversight of the cybersecurity efforts across all state agencies with ITS providing centralized management and coordination of state policies for the security of data and information technology resources.

Senate Bill 3001 (Regular Session 2017), *effective July 1, 2017*

Approved by Governor Bryant on April 18, 2017

- Department of Information Technology Services Appropriation Bill for Fiscal Year 2018.

Senate Nomination 15 (Regular Session 2017), *effective July 1, 2016*

Appointment Confirmed by the Senate on March 28, 2017

- June Rose Lynn (June) Songy, Purvis, Mississippi, Information Technology Services Authority, five year term beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2021.

Senate Nomination 59 (Regular Session 2017), *effective July 1, 2017*

Appointment Confirmed by the Senate on March 28, 2017

- John Alan (Alan) Lange, Jackson, Mississippi, Information Technology Services Authority, term beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2022.
