

MS Department of Information Technology Services (ITS) 2021 Legislative Summary

Senate Bill 2474 (Regular Session 2021), *effective upon passage* Approved by Governor Reeves on April 9, 2021

 Amend Section 27-104-203, Mississippi Code of 1972,to clarify provisions necessary for the implementation, operation and/or enforcement of the State's Medical Marijuana Program relating to expenditures by the Department without an appropriation, escalating personnel positions in the Department, and exemption from Information Technology laws and regulations; and for related purposes.

Senate Bill 2950 (Regular Session 2021), *effective July 1, 2021* Approved by Governor Reeves April 20, 2021

 Department of Information Technology Services Appropriation Bill for Fiscal Year 2022.

Senate Bill 2956 (Regular Session 2021), effective upon passage Approved by Governor Reeves on April 22, 2021

 Additional appropriations for various state agencies including \$700,000 in special fund spending authority to the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services to defray the expenses of the Department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021. This additional appropriation is for the purpose of providing services to support state agencies as needed.
