2022 Legislative Summary

Senate Bill 2095 (Regular Session 2022), *effective upon passage*
Approved by Governor Reeves on February 2, 2022

- To amend section 25-53-5, Mississippi code of 1972,to temporarily exempt acquisitions of Information Technology Equipment and Services made by the Mississippi Department of Health and the Mississippi Department of Revenue for the purposes of implementing, administering and enforcing the provisions of the Mississippi Medical Cannabis Act. From Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services procurement laws, rules, and regulations.

Senate Bill 3047 (Regular Session 2022), *effective July 1, 2022*
Approved by Governor Reeves April 18, 2022

Senate Nomination 38 (Regular Session 2022), *appointment confirmed April 1, 2022*
