Cloud Systems Team Lead

We are looking for a team lead that will be responsible for working to build out our enterprise public cloud configurations and work with executive management to build out a team over the coming months.

- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to design and implement scalable, secure, and highly available cloud-based solutions on Amazon Web Services (AWS) and Microsoft Azure Cloud
- Help build, train, and lead a public cloud team composed of AWS and Azure Cloud specialists, with the primary goal to provide agencies with the best cloud solution for their needs
- Work with different AWS and Azure Cloud services and understand the service offerings and best practices of each
- Work directly with agencies to onboard them to AWS and Azure Cloud, and to create accounts and secure workload areas.
- Monitor agencies' monthly utilization and billing to ensure enterprise cost efficiencies
- Assist with the migration of a subset of on-premises applications to AWS and Azure Cloud
- Help to automate the deployment, management, and ongoing administration of cloud infrastructure on AWS and Azure Cloud

- Monitor and troubleshoot AWS/Azure Cloud-based systems and applications
