IT Project Manager II

The Mississippi Wireless Communication Commission (MSWCC) is tasked with promoting the efficient use of public resources to ensure that law enforcement personnel and essential public health and safety personnel have effective communications services available in an emergency situation, and to ensure the rapid restoration of such communications services in the event of disruption caused by natural disaster, terrorist attack, or other public emergency. MSWCC operates a P25 Land Mobile Radio System with point-to-point microwave backhaul providing 97% statewide mobile radio coverage. MSWCC assists, reviews, and signs-off on all state and local wireless communication systems procurements, assists with the establishment of state and local wireless communications, and provides system planning and technical support to all public safety entities. MSWCC is governed by a 16-member commission comprised of state and local representatives.

Key Responsibilities

The Wireless Communications Commission (WCC) is seeking qualified persons for the role of IT Project Manager II. This position is accountable for assisting with the maintenance and sustainability of operations for a LMR (Land Mobile Radio) statewide system. Monitors and troubleshoots network performance.

- Assists with site operations and management including preventative maintenance and repairs of mechanical equipment including HVAC, generators, UPS, tower lighting, grounds, tower structures, and shelters.
- Assists with system operations including upgrades, testing, troubleshooting, and diagnostics.
- Assists with reviewing vendor/contractor work and deliverables.
- Assists with resource allocations including mobile emergency communication resources.
- Assists with Federal Communication Commission license filings in compliance with rules and regulations for a P25 LMR with microwave backhaul communication network supporting more than 59,000 subscribers.

Preferred Experience/Education

Typically requires a Bachelor's degree and minimum of 6-10 years of relevant experience. Experience may be substituted for education.
