IT Project Manager II

Roles in this job family are accountable for the identification, analysis, planning, execution, and completion of projects for IT solutions of an IT team to ensure projects achieve their goals and meet pre-defined outcomes including contract and external vendor deliverables.

Key Responsibilities

- Defines systems scope, objectives, and functionality based on user input and understanding of business processes
- Manage complex projects including scheduling and facilitating meetings with stakeholders and managing timelines
- Provides proactive communication of project status, issues, and risks to team and stakeholders
- Oversees the development and deployment of various voice and data network technologies and processes in designated functional areas
- May be responsible for developing documentation and post-implementation training.
- Will be responsible for interfacing between vendor partners and internal groups consisting of billing, change management advisory board, etc.

- Critical thinking and Problem-solving: understands complex business issues and how to solve them through technology and collaboration
- Experience with public procurement processes including writing RFP specifications and evaluating responses
- Self-motivated learner: able to take input from various sources and compile that knowledge

- Excellent written and verbal communication including technical writing skills
- Ability to work with highly technical people
