Senate Bill 2046 (Regular Session 2019), effective July 1, 2019 Approved by Governor Bryant on March 29, 2019

 Exempt certain information technology records from the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983.

Senate Bill 3052 (Regular Session 2019), effective July 1, 2019 Approved by Governor Bryant on April 14, 2019
