Is seeking a contract worker as a Senior Network Engineer. The contract worker will be responsible for network engineering support of the State of Mississippi capitol complex fiber network, statewide MPLS wide area network and State data centers. Qualified applicants should have at least twenty (20) years of experience with the following: State government networking including the State of MS capitol complex fiber network, statewide MPLS network, and State data center networks; Technical network design, day-to-day network management and troubleshooting; Quality of service (QoS), voice over IP (VoIP) implementation, management and troubleshooting; Cisco routing and switching technologies; and Border gateway protocol (BGP) carrier class routing. Additionally, qualified candidates should have experience with Infoblox DNS/IPAM implementation, management, and support; LiveAction NetFlow monitoring; CA service center help desk; and Cisco Application Centric Infrastructure (ACI) data center fabric design, management, and support. The term of the contract shall be one (1) year. The rate of pay shall be fifty-two dollars (\$52) per hour (not including travel) not to exceed \$74,100.00 per year. All new hires are subject to fingerprinting and a background check. Contract Worker will not be deemed as independent, and all employment taxes will be withheld and matched.
